- **“2 Termination”**

M/F            N  
 ex:      fortis,      forte

- **“1 Termination”**

M/F/N      (gen.)  
 ex:      potēns,      potentis

**Declining 3<sup>rd</sup> Declension Adjectives:** (Remember the 1<sup>st</sup> Rule!)
