To form the Present Active Infinitive:

- Present Stem (base/root + conj. vowel) + -se (< -si < -sī)
- However, in Latin, an intervocalic "s" (= between two vowels) will rhotacize to an "r"

Find the Present Stem:

- Pres. Act. Inf. "re" **OR** Present base + conj. vowel
- Note: Laryngeals!
