#### Future of *Sum*, esse:

- Combine the stem with the standard PIE thematic vowels (o/e/e/e/o) as a tense marker; allow for rhotacization
- Add the present system personal endings, the usual vowels undergo weakening

#### Imperfect of *Sum, esse*:

- Combine the stem with the tense marker "ā"; allow for rhotacization
- Add the present system personal endings, the usual vowels undergo shortening

#### **POSSUM, POSSE:** "to be able"\*\*

- This verb is a combination of *sum, esse* and the prefix "pot-" (meaning: "able", "have power").
- If you know the forms of *sum, esse*, you already know the forms of *possum, posse*
- Just allow for assimilation of the "t" of "pot-" to **assimilate** when it meets an initial "s" in *sum, esse*
