manēbant – 3<sup>rd</sup> pl. inpf. act. indic. – māneō, mānere, mānsi, mānsum – to remain

verba – neut. Nom./acc./voc. pl. – verbum, -i, nt. – word

tolerābō – 1<sup>st</sup> sing. fut. act. indic. – tolerō, tolerāre, tolerāvī, tolerātum – to endure/hear

librō – masc., dat./abl. sing.; liber, librī, m. – book
